# **Chardon Area Chamber of Commerce 2023 Scholarship Fund Guidelines**

Graduating seniors who are residents of the Chardon Local School District (as defined by the Chardon Local Schools) and who have applied to an accredited vocational, two/four year degree-granting institute of post-secondary education are eligible for the Chardon Area Chamber of Commerce Scholarship.

## **Qualifications and Guidelines:**

- 1. The applicant has participated in at least two extra-curricular or community service activities while enrolled as a student.
- 2. The applicant has attained a minimum grade point average of 3.00.
- 3. The applicant should demonstrate leadership qualities and upstanding character traits.
- 4. The applicant must be a resident of the Chardon Local School District.

# **Application Procedure:**

- 1. Each applicant must complete the application and return it to the Chardon Area Chamber of Commerce by the specified deadline indicated below.
- 2. Two recommendations must accompany the application. One can be from a teacher and or faculty member. The other must be from a non-faculty member who is not a relative. Forms and instructions are provided with the application.
- 3. The successful applicants will be awarded the scholarship during the Chamber Banquet scheduled in person for March 21<sup>st</sup> from 5:30-8:00 pm with the location to be determined. The winner and his or her parents are invited to attend the dinner and community awards ceremony as guests of the Chamber.

#### **Amount of Scholarship:**

The Chamber will award up to two scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each.

## When to Apply:

Applications will be made available at high schools located in the district and online at chardonchamber.com. The deadline is March 3<sup>rd</sup> at 5 pm.
